### Baby Basics of Collier County 2018 Project Summary

The mission of [Baby Basics of Collier County](#) is simple: to provide disposable diapers, kindness, and a sense of community to low-income working families who receive no federal or state government cash assistance. The goal is to make things easier for these working families by doing one thing well – providing a consistent supply of free diapers for children under the age of three to eligible families.

Baby Basics opened its 11<sup>th</sup> distribution site three years ago with the help of The League Club. A grant from the League Club will allow this site at Catholic Charities to continue to support local families and expand the number of families served. After Hurricane Irma, Baby Basics together with the National Diaper Bank collaborated to distribute donated diapers to the hardest hit areas of Collier County. The lingering effects of Irma have resulted in more families who did not qualify for this program previously now needing diaper support.

### Neighborhood Health Clinic 2018 Project Summary

The [Neighborhood Health Clinic](#) will use grant monies from the League Club to purchase a Piccolo and vaccine refrigerator. The Piccolo is a lab workhorse that can provide 15 tests in 12-20 minutes. It is the most frequently used instrument in the lab. A new piccolo will generate over 14,000 test results, over a 2-year span at the Neighborhood Health Clinic.

In addition, the grant will purchase a new vaccine refrigerator unit for the pharmacy. Temperature control is critical for medication storage including many common drugs such as insulin. During Hurricane Irma the clinic faced the prospect of losing medications valued at \$2.5 million. This grant will help the Neighborhood Health Clinic to fulfill its mission to provide quality medical and dental care to low income working, but uninsured, adults in Collier County.

## New Horizons of SWFL 2018 Project Summary

Dedicated to serving children growing up in an environment of poverty, academic failure and helplessness, [New Horizons](#) offers tutoring, mentoring and character-development for 480+ at-risk children and teens at seven locations in Lee and Collier. A League Club grant for 2018 will provide funds for six Super Kids Reading Camps this summer. During the four-week camp, 250 at-risk students in grades K-5th grades will focus on improving their reading fluency, phonics, and word recognition skills so they won't lose ground over the summer and can look forward to their next grade level with confidence.

The camp features a 10:1 teacher - student ratio. Students attend Monday through Friday from 8:30 to noon and they enjoy songs, games, Friday swims as well as breakfast and lunch in addition to reading lessons. Plus, they will receive back to school shoes from Laces of Love and book bags with school supplies from Estero UMC. They will be school ready this fall!

## Boys & Girls Club of Collier County 2018 Project Summary

Based on the excellent outcomes of its career and technical education programming, the [Boys & Girls Club of Collier County](#) has expanded and enhanced its vocational programs with two new culinary arts programs. A grant from the League Club will help this become a reality.

The Junior Culinary Arts Program will employ certified culinary staff to provide teens with hands-on job training in career development, apprenticeship, customer service, community service and culinary arts. Program participants will also be able to earn culinary certifications (ServSafe Certificates) which gives them an advantage in post-graduation employment. The 12-week curriculum will be held twice a year with an abbreviated course during the summer. A second culinary program will be introduced to elementary and middle school youth, giving them an early understating of the culinary arts, kitchen safety and cooking basics.
