

How nonprofit agencies can apply for grants by July 1

The League Club announced the launch of its 2019-20 grant awards program for Collier and Lee County nonprofit agencies. Nonprofit agencies wishing to file a letter of intent to apply for a grant are invited to do so by July 1. The League Club provides charitable funding to nonprofits serving Collier and Lee counties classified by the IRS as 501(c)(3) organizations.

Grants may be awarded to nonprofit agencies who:

- Serve human services needs of at-risk women, children and the elderly
- Educate and promote conservation of natural resources
- Provide education and participation in the arts, with particular emphasis on providing opportunities for under-served students

"The League Club is proud to assist agencies in their efforts to raise the quality of life for Collier and Lee county residents. We believe our grants program has played a vital and sustaining role in our community over the last 32 years," said President Gigi Stewart.

Vice President Community Susan Harris said, "Grants awarded to 35 area nonprofits in April 2019 represented a strong, strategic investment in our community to support education, hunger and health care that make a real difference in the lives of kids and families. Today, we are seeking letters of intent for new grant proposals for funding in April 2020."
