PHYSICIAN LED ACCESS NETWORK OF COLLIER COUNTY (PLAN) INCREASING ACCESS TO PATIENT CARE

All services are free of charge to qualified PLAN members. PLAN is a referral network program of 150 volunteer physicians, community clinics, hospitals and other affiliated health care providers who help to provide a safety net of access to quality healthcare for qualified low-income and uninsured adult residents of Collier County in Florida.

To be eligible:

- You must be a Collier County adult resident between the ages of 19 to 64.
- You must be able to provide proof of Collier County residency for at least 6 months prior to making application.
- You must not have health insurance of any kind, are not eligible for Medicare, or Medicaid; and have an immediate medical need.
- Your individual and family income must be below 200% of Federal Poverty Guidelines.
- You do not have to have U.S. citizenship.
- Enrollment is for a 6-month period subject to meeting program guidelines. If requested, an extension may be granted pending continued eligibility and continued treatment.

The League Club grant helped fund the cost of prescription medications and laboratory services for approximately 634 PLAN clients in 2020. In doing so, The League Club helped participants have an improved quality of life, a better chance at maintaining family stability, and if employed, an improved ability to continue in their field of work.
