CIC in Action



Baby Basics, an organization created on a national level in 1992 and in Naples in 2003, provides a carton on disposable diapers per month for eligible families. To qualify, families must have a child 3 years old or under, have one of the 2 parents employed, and earn no more than 190% of the poverty level. During the pandemic, work requirements have been relaxed so families have not missed a monthly distribution.

Baby Basics is the only non-profit in Collier County that gives a continual monthly supply of diapers to babies under the age of 3. The League Club grant will provide a one-year supply of to 33 babies of low-income working families.
